**CONSTRUCTION NOTES:** No, we are not creating a balcony skylight! The hole in the ceiling, which requires half the balcony be closed, was due to a mishap by a contractor installing insulation. The contractor has assumed responsibility for fixing the ceiling. The insulation installation is at no cost to St. V because it is part of a grant for energy efficiency improvements from the Maryland Energy Administration. Work on the restoration of the front façade's masonry and woodwork is nearly complete; however we are still awaiting the reinstallation of the refurbished stained glass and its new protective glass covering.
